Message from the chair of the ATTO 9 conference

Thank you for submitting your abstract to the upcoming ATTO 9 conference which will be held on 9-14 July on Jeju Island (<http://atto9.org>), Korea. We appreciate your interest in the conference. Regarding abstract review and flight ticket booking:

We have received a large number of abstracts, around 250, and the international program committee is currently reviewing them to select contributed speakers. We understand that you may be eager to know the outcome, and we assure you that we will announce the review results as soon as possible, which should be within the next few weeks. We would like to emphasize that the ATTO conference tradition ensures that everyone who submitted an abstract will have a chance to present. If you selected 'oral presentation or both' but not selected, you will have a chance to present as a poster. Therefore, you do not need to wait for the review result to book your flight ticket. We recommend that you book your flight tickets to Jeju Island as soon as possible, as it is a popular place for summer vacation.

Regarding hotel booking & registration:

In keeping with the tradition of the ATTO conference, we aim to bring all the participants together in one space to foster networking and interaction among attendees. For this reason, we recommend that you stay at the Booyoung Hotel and Resort, where the conference will take place. The hotel booking will be available from **22 May**, and we will announce it again when it is available.

Regarding the conference schedule:
